Applications are invited from candidates meeting the following qualifications for engagement as Apprentices under Apprentices Act 1961 (as amended from time to time) in the trade/disciplines mentioned below:

Note: It is mandatory to have Aadhaar Seeded Bank account to receive 50% of stipend from Board of Apprenticeship and Training (BOAT) under Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) Scheme in respect of Graduate & Technician Apprentice.

Eligibility Criteria and General Terms & Conditions

1. Before applying, candidates should ensure that they fulfill the eligibility criteria and other norms mentioned in the advertisement.
2. Candidate should possess above-mentioned qualification from UGC/ AICTE approved Institution.
3. Candidate should have obtained Diploma in Engineering & Technology in the year 2025, 2024, 2023, 2022 and 2021 only.
4. Age limit of candidate should be 18 years to 30 years as on 31/08/2025.
5. Candidate should be registered on NATS and possess valid enrollment id.
6. The last date for submitting the online application is 15/1/26. Applications submitted after the last date will not be accepted. Incomplete or partially filled applications will not be entertained.
7. Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/PWD categories will be applicable as per the provisions of the Apprentices Act, 1961, the Apprentice Rules, 1992, and the Apprenticeship (Amendment) Rules, 2019.

8. Candidate applying for apprenticeship should have not taken apprenticeship training earlier from any establishment under NATS on NAPS.
9. Any delay or update for reimbursement process from NATS and MAY of the mentioned amount, establishment will not be responsible.
10. Institute reserves the right to shortlist the applications and cancel the candidature of an applicant.
11. Selection will be based on two stages. **First stage** will be an MCQ test to assess basic subject knowledge, followed by a personal interview in second stage. The final selection will be based on the cumulative performance at both stages subject to satisfactory verification of documents.
12. Selected candidates will be informed via the email ID mentioned in their application. Candidates are advised to check their emails regularly and ensure their email ID remains active until the selection process is complete. The institute will not be responsible for non-receipt of any communication resulting from a change in mobile number or email ID.
13. Candidates must bring the original and self-attested copies of the following documents during document verification at the time of joining:

Documents to be carried:

- a) Printout of Application: Duly signed printout of the submitted application by the candidate
 - b) Educational Certificates:
 1. SSC (10th) mark sheet and certificate
 2. HSC (12th) mark sheet and certificate (if applicable)
 3. Degree certificate /provisional degree certificate
 - c) Category Certificate (if applicable): SC/ST/OBC certificate (OBC candidates must provide a valid non-creamy layer certificate for the stipulated period)
 - d) Disability Certificate (if applicable): PWD certificate issued by a competent authority.
 - e) Government-Issued Photo ID Proof: Any valid Photo ID card issued by the Government of India or Government of Gujarat, such as PAN Card, Voter ID Card (EPIC), Driving License, Passport.
 - f) Aadhaar Card: Mandatory for identity verification
 - g) Bank Details: Aadhaar-seeded bank passbook or statement (Aadhaar-linked bank account is compulsory)
 - h) Medical Fitness Certificate: A fitness certificate issued by a Government Hospital/PHCs within the last 3 months from the date of selection, is required.
 - i) Photographs: Two recent passport-size photographs.
4. Candidates selected for training will not be allowed to withdraw from training except for reasons beyond their control. Before the commencement of training, the candidate will have to execute a contract of apprenticeship on the respective portals.
 5. Selected Candidates will have to produce valid Police Verification Certificate either from their place of last residence (for at least past one year) or permanent address at the time of joining.
 6. No correspondence shall be entertained from candidates who are not selected for apprenticeship training.
 7. The institute reserves the right to amend / reschedule / cancel / suspend / the selection process at any time without assigning any reason whatsoever. The decision of the institute shall be final and binding, and no appeal of any kind shall be accepted/ considered in this regard.

Instructions:

1. Verification of documents shall be done for selected candidates prior to the creation of the contract only and in case of any deviation from or non-conformity with the desired qualification/eligibility criteria; the candidature of the candidate shall be rejected.
2. All qualifications must be from Indian institutions recognized by the appropriate statutory authority.
3. Suppression of facts will also lead to disqualification at any stage of the selection process or during the apprenticeship period.
4. Candidates who have already undergone apprenticeship training or at present undergoing apprenticeship training under any organization are *not eligible* to apply.
5. Candidates with more than one year work experience are not eligible to apply. For the same, the candidate has to sign the self- declaration.
6. No TA/DA will be paid to the applicants called for the selection process at the institute.
7. The candidate selected as apprentice will not be provided any residence and transport by the institute at the time of interview and also during the apprenticeship period.
8. The engagement and training are strictly in compliance with the provision of the Apprenticeship Act 1961 and there is no obligation for employment of apprentices on the completion of their apprenticeship.
9. Any canvassing or personal follow up during the process of selection by and behalf of any candidate shall lead to immediate cancellation of candidature.
10. Principal, Government Engineering College, Valsad reserves the right to terminate apprenticeship if circumstances so warrant without assigning any reason thereof.
11. Any disputes arising out of this advertisement for the engagement of apprentices will be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts in Valsad District only.
12. The selected candidates should abide by the rules and regulations framed by the institute from time to time.
